



Book: A written work or composition that has been published - typically printed on pages bound together

Structure: Last, F. M. (Year Published). Book title. City, State: Publisher.



Page 2 The subsequent pages after the cover will have publication information


Citing a published book found on a website - APA

Cite it at easybib.com

Structure: Last, F. M. (Year Published). Book title. Retrieved from URL

*Note: If not yet indexed or difficult to find from the homepage, then include the full URL. Otherwise, use the homepage URL.

Website: Google books



Date accessed: Only include if the source is one that might change

Note: When citing sources reproduced online from their print versions, it is not necessary to include online information such as the website publisher or the date of electronic publication

Citation: Twain, M. (1999). *The adventures of Tom Sawyer.* Retrieved from http://books.google.com




Citing a published book found on a database - APA Cite it at easybib.com

Structure: Last, F. M. (Year Published) *Book title*. City, State: Publisher. Retrieved from URL.

*Note: Add homepage URL of publisher. If none, use the homepage URL. If published only online, use unique URL
